## WE CANNOT WAIT UNTIL THE WAR IS OVER



- NATIONAL CHALLENGE: UKRAINE NEEDS LOW INCOME, SOCIAL HOUSING TO STABILIZE THE INTERNAL HOUSING DILEMMA BUT ALSO TO ATTRACT UKRAINIAN REFUGEES FROM ABROAD.
- LOCAL CONSTRUCTION SOLUTIONS ARE LOW COST AND KEY TO RESOLVING SHORT AND LONG-TERM HOUSING NEEDS.
- Paired WITH DONATIONS, the KEY IS SECURING INEXPENSIVE, LONG-TERM FINANCING SOLUTIONS BOTH FOR CONSTRUCTION AS WELL AS FOR MORTGAGES.
- COMMUNITY-BASED REHABILITATION CENTERS AND SERVICES ARE CRITICALLY NEEDED FOR VETERANS AND THOSE AFFECTED BY THE WAR.

Our key objectives include: renovation of the quarantine room equipped with new enclosures to ensure safe and hygienic isolation when needed; renovation of warm indoor spaces for providing winter care to animals, especially those vulnerable to cold temperatures; installation of outdoor enclosures designed for larger dogs; installation of water supply and drainage system to maintain better hygiene and sanitation across the shelter. Additionally, we're creating a more livable space for caregivers like Serhiy, a displaced resident from Mariupol. He found refuge at the shelter with his dog.

## MOVE UKRAINE LIVES: SUPPORTING THE HEALTH OF IDPs



This Dental Health program, launched on November 14th by MoveUkraine “Lives,” in partnership with the Kalush City Dental Clinic and sponsored by our American anonymous donor “Borys” and the Dental Group “Porcelain”, serves the 150 IDPs, children and adults, residing in our 5 Ivano-Frankivsk region Shelter homes that were renovated by MoveUkraine. To date, 90 patients have been treated.

The program includes 2 phases:

Phase 1: check-up, tooth cleaning with the hygienist and treatment plan.

Phase 2 follows with treatment on a priority basis.

Emergency treatment is attended to during either phases.





## Description

launched by MoveUkraine “Lives” in partnership with dr.Paul Runge, an ophthalmologist and volunteer from the USA, this program is designed to provide complete eye check-up and diabetes detection for displaced children and adults, residing in our 5 Ivano-Frankivsk region Shelter homes. MoveUkraine covers transportation, food and beverage. dr.Paul Runge covers materials and volunteers his diagnostic services.

## Scope of work

The Ophthalmologist travels with a moveukraine volunteer for translation to the shelter where he meets the residents and performs his examination. then he provides consultation on vision correction, prevention and treatment of disease. however he is not able to offer corrective glasses or blood sugar control devices.



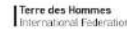
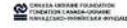
